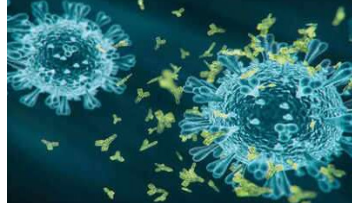

in the concerned global institutions sceptical regarding the authenticity of the statistics of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare resulting in the WHO placing India in the category for which the Covid death figures are to be generated through modelling and not based on the officially reported numbers.

The CRS used to be a purely administrative data collection system but the coverage has increased significantly, thanks to greater awareness and enhanced field level surveillance and follow-ups. There has been a jump in registrations starting from 2018. Such jumps are not infrequent, caused by procedural changes and backlog reporting.

Given this, the selection of the base years to be used for estimating "normal deaths" becomes extremely important. If one chooses to use, say the average deaths during 2015-2019, one will get a higher "excess death" estimate compared to using only 2018 and 2019 for the baseline comparison.
