This year the theme for World Liver Day 2026 is "Solid Habits, Strong Liver". ups can protect the liver and reduce the risk of disease. The liver is the second largest and one of the most vital organs in the human body. Remarkably, the liver can self-heal and regenerate even after 60-70% damage, but persistent neglect can still lead to severe complications.

Additionally, 200 crore adults are overweight or obese, and 40 crore live with diabetes, both key risk factors for non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) and liver cancer. While viral hepatitis remains widespread, drug-induced liver injury is now emerging as a major cause of acute hepatitis. Compared to 2005, new liver disease cases are projected to rise by 35% annually by 2030. Much of this rise is linked to low awareness about risk factors, late detection, and preventable lifestyle habits. On World Liver Day, hepatologists, healthcare policymakers, and liver specialists come forward to educate the public on prevention through diet, exercise, and lifestyle changes. Since most liver diseases remain silent in early stages, WLD also stresses the value of regular screening and knowing the warning signs. Protecting your liver starts with daily choices - because a strong liver means a stronger you. World Liver Day serves as a vital reminder that liver health cannot be taken for granted.

Gandhinagar A police complaint has been filed against Chetan Patel, the administrator of Gyan Live, a well-known online academy with a big name in the education world across Gujarat including Gandhinagar, with serious allegations. A student working as a freelance in the academy demanded Rs. 3.05 lakh as his remuneration, and the administrator publicly humiliated him and threatened to beat him up in the room. GIFT City's shoot space fraud worth over Rs 100 crore

Aravalli Congress president arrested, Utpal fled abroad with his wife, properties including land will be confiscated

Gandhinagar, A case has finally been registered against the managers and responsible persons of the company in the Dabhoda police station for defrauding investors of crores of rupees in the name of data storage and investment in terabyte space by a company named Shootspace Digital Private Limited operating in Gandhinagar's GIFT City. It has been revealed that the company does not have any server or data storage facilities. Two people, including Aravalli District Congress President Arun Patel, have been arrested in this case. In this case, action will also be taken to seize Utpal Patel's properties. In the preliminary investigation, this scam is likely to go up to 100 crores. Currently, 13 complainants have come forward. With whom five crores have been cheated in the name of investment. Preparations have also been made to issue a look out notice against Utpal. A case has been registered against Utpal Patel, director of Shoot Space Company, Utpal Patel's wife Bhumi Patel, Arun Patel, Arun Rai and Sachin Patel and Dhruv Chaudhary. In this case, a case has been registered under sections 316, 5, 318 of cheating, then forgery, along with sections 3 of the GPAD Act and sections 21 and 23 of the BUDS Act. Reliable sources said that Utpal Patel has fled to Dubai along with his family. He has bought about four bighas of land to build a resort in Udaipur. Apart from this, he has two flats. Apart from this, he has an office in Gift City and an office in Infocity. He also has a house and land in Modasa. A look out notice will be issued to take him back from Dubai. In addition, his bank accounts will also be frozen. The third accused in this case will also be caught soon. However, the main mastermind Utpal Patel, apart from his wife, has revealed in the preliminary investigation that the managers are millionaires on paper.

percent of the investment in a year. 'The police are investigating, the CA has also been called by the police, the process of looking at the documents with the CA is underway. So far, no evidence has come to light that this company has taken any loan from any bank. The investigation is ongoing. One car was purchased and the car is on loan, apart from that, the investigation is ongoing to find out how much loan the company has taken.'

Arrest of 2 including Aravalli District Congress President 'Two people have been arrested in this case. Aravalli District Congress President Arun Virchand Patel (Res. Bolundra, Umedpur Taluka Modasa, G. Aravalli)) has been arrested. He was the director of a cloud easy company along with Utpal Patel and one Sachin Amrit Patel (Nawa Naroda, Ahmedabad) was the zonal manager of Utpal Patel. He used to sell schemes to the public sitting in the company. Both of them have been arrested.' This is a very preliminary stage investigation. It can be estimated that there could be more than 5,000 investors. The exact figure will be determined after investigating, talking to the investors and then sitting with the CA. 'Arun Patel was also a partner till October. He left the company after October but no transfer was made in his account till October, from the accused's account, due to which Arun Patel has been arrested. Along with this, another accused who was the previous director will also be taken action against him. No person named Dubey also has any role as a director on any paper in any of his companies, Dubey's role will be investigated.'

The company had lured investors with monthly and fixed rents by transferring the money to another company and had created false documents and invoices to gain the trust of the investors. The company had transferred the

amount collected from the investors to its other businesses such as CloudG Technology Limited and Harry Hospitality and Leisure Limited, thereby embezzling the investors' capital.

The accused involved in this crime include Utpal Patel, founder and

director of Shootspace Digital Pvt. Ltd., Director Arun Rameshchandra Rai, Arunbhai Virchandbhai Patel, board of directors of CloudG Digital Pvt. Ltd., Sachinbhai Amritbhai Patel, zonal manager of Shootspace Digital Pvt. Ltd., Bhumi Utpal Patel, board of directors of Harry Hospitality and Leisure Ltd., and Dhruv Jagdish Chaudhary, additional director of Shootspace Digital Pvt. Ltd. and director of Harry Hospitality and Leisure Ltd.

According to the complaint filed by Bhaveshpuri Mahendrapuri Bawa, the company's managers have closed the office and fled. In this scam, apart from the complainant, 12 other investors have been defrauded of a total amount of more than Rs 4.90 crore. Currently, the police have started an intensive investigation into this matter.
